EXECUTIVE EVALUATION SUB COMMITTEE MEETING February 27, 2014

- 1. Mr. Flynn called the meeting of the Executive Evaluation sub committee to order at 5:50 PM.

- 4. Ms. Silvers made a motion to approve the Superintendent's revised Entry Findings Report with the revisions of the EE Sub Committee and the Executive Evaluation Sub Committee's mid-year evaluation of Mr. Hastings. Ms. Sahn seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously.
- 5. Mr. Hastings thanked the members of the Executive Evaluation sub committee for their help and valuable assistance throughout the past months and through this evaluation process.
- 5. Mr. Flynn noted that Mr. Hastings has given this process real meaning and as a result, the whole process, that easily could have been just been given lip service, was taken seriously by all members of the Executive Evaluation sub committee. All members agreed with Mr. Flynn's assessment.
