Reopening Task Force Planning Principles

- 1. Health, safety, and well-being of our students, faculty, staff, families, and our school community above all else.
- 2. Intentional about matters of equity and begins by first addressing the needs of our most vulnerable student populations.
- 3. Builds from our Vision and Core Values.
- 4. Builds on our strengths.
- 5. Incorporates feedback, reflections, and lessons learned during this period of school closure.
- 6. Allows for flexibility and fluidity in how we deliver instruction and strives for a continuum of services, acknowledging the varying student needs across the PK-12 range and responding to differences in age-appropriate ways.
- 7. A plan that incorporates guidance from state and local officials, and federal, state and local health professionals.
- 8. A plan that takes into account the needs of ALL stakeholders (students, families, and staff) and builds in continued flexibilities.
- 9. Connect with and support students, staff, parents and caregivers by building in regular opportunities for feedback.
- 10. Ensure that plans are sustainable and take into account the mental, physical, social, and emotional needs of the school community.
