6. Allows for flexibility and fluidity in how we deliver instruction and strives for a continuum of services, acknowledging the varying student needs across the PK-12 range and responding to differences in age-appropriate ways.
7. A plan that incorporates guidance from state and local officials, and federal, state and local health professionals.
8. A plan that takes into account the needs of ALL stakeholders (students, families, and staff) and builds in continued flexibilities.
9. Connect with and support students, staff, parents and caregivers by building in regular opportunities for feedback.
10. Ensure that plans are sustainable and take into account the mental, physical, social, and emotional needs of the school community.
